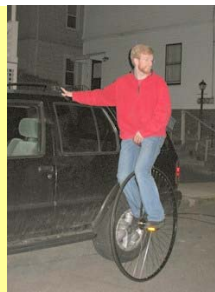


The Mobile Mini Circus for Children is an organisation that relearns children in Afghanistan how to play. That is badly needed in a country where poverty, drought, earth quakes and war have taken away their innocent and spontaneous laughter. And the Afghani adults are too occupied with just surviving to concern themselves a lot with their children's needs.



Zach Warren, an American student and unicyclist, has set a goal of raising ten thousand dollars for the MMCC. He will do this by seeking sponsors for this attempt to break a Guinness world record.

On May 10, 2006, he wants to cover 100 miles (160.9 km!) on a unicycle, within the current world record time of 6 hours, 44 minutes and 21.84 seconds.
